



Bruno Rambaudi, Vice President of the TOROC, Organising Committee for the XX Olympic Winter Games Torino 2006

Born on September 29th 1938, for over 30 years Bruno Rambaudi has performed entrepreneurial activities in the mechanical sector developing production and commercial activities in Italy and abroad.

At the same time he has worked energetically through the years in the associative field, holding many executive roles: he has been President of the Italian tool machine builders (*UCIMU* of the European tool machines builders (*CECIMO*, of the metal-mechanical industrial association of Torino (*AMMA – Associazione Industriali Metallurgici Metalmeccanici Affini di Torino*).

He has also served as President of the Industrial Union (*Unione Industriale*) of Torino, and of the Piedmontese businessmen's federation (*Federpiemonte*), as well as vice president of Italian businessmen's federation (*Confindustria*).

In February 2000, he was appointed Vice president of the TOROC (Torino 2006 Organising Committee); in this position Bruno Rambaudi has contributed to develop relationships with the Olympic Committees of Beijing and Vancouver, organising economic and promotional missions of the Piedmontese territory in these two cities.
